

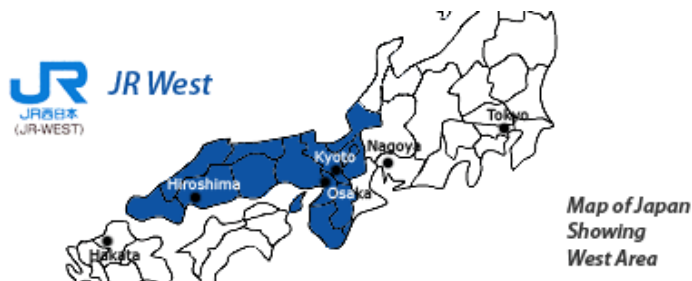


Conditions valid from 01 Apr to 31 Dec 2010

IMPORTANT NOTE: Tickets issued on Euronet are considered as "Exchange Order" which should be exchanged in Japan to receive a Japan Rail Sanyo Pass

- "JR" often stands for Japan Railways. JR is not a company but an intricate railway network Japan's railway system is extremely safe and punctual.
- The Japan Rail Sanyo Pass is the cheapest and most convenient way to explore Sanyo area Some of the recommended attractions in Sanyo include Osaka, Okayama, Hiroshima and Hakata.

I. Features

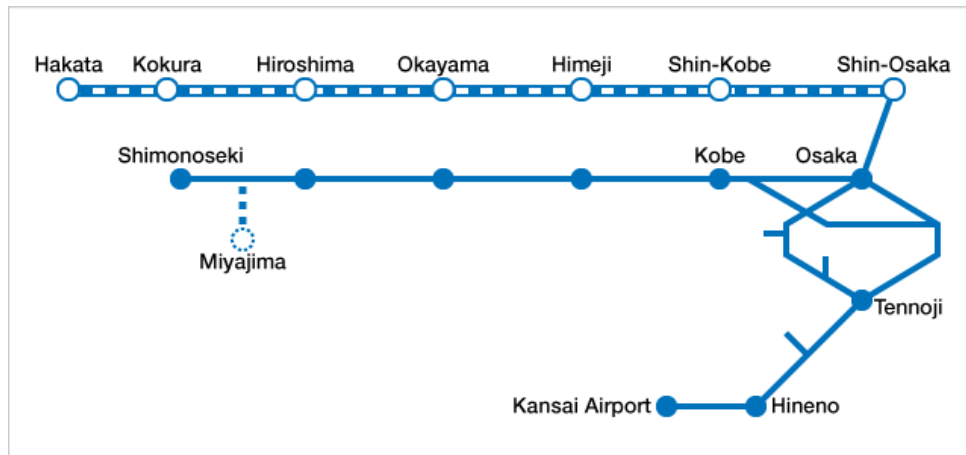


- The JR Sanyo Pass allows unlimited travel on Tokaido- Sanyo Main Line (Shin-Osaka-Shimonoseki)

Osaka Loop Line	JR Tozai Line
Sakurajima Line	Kansai Main Line (JR Namba- Imamiya)
Hanwa Line (Tennoji- Hineno)	Kansai Airport Line

Miyajima Ferry

- The Sanyo Area Pass allows unlimited use, within the designated area, of many trains and transportation services operated by JR-West.
- These include the "Nozomi", "Hikari", and "Kodama" Sanyo Shinkansen super express trains, "Haruka" limited express trains, ordinary class cars on local trains including reserved and non-reserved seats, and the Miyajima ferry line in Hiroshima that goes to Miyajima Island.



Validity period and prices

Ordinary Pass (coach class/2nd class)

- 4 consecutive days
- 8 consecutive days

- The validity period of a Japan Rail Sanyo Pass is consecutive and start on the date the pass is actually first used.

How to make seat reservations?



- Seat reservations can be made without additional payment. Travellers cannot reserve a seat until they receive their Japan West Rail Sanyo Pass in Japan.
- A non-reserved seat can be used simply by presenting their personal Japan Sanyo Pass.
- To make a reservation, travellers must go to any Travel Service Center or a Reservation Office

(Midori-no-madoguchi)- green pictogram- at a JR station, or to the sales office of a JR-associated travel agency. There, showing their PASS, they obtain the reserved-seat ticket before the boarding.

The periods when seat reservations are particularly difficult to secure are as follows:

- **December 25th to January 5th:** The New Year holiday period is the most popular travel time for Japanese people, for vacations and returns to hometowns areas.
- **April 29th to May 5th:** Due to consecutive holidays in a comfortable travel season, there is a large-scale travel throughout Japan for leisure and recreation.
- **August 13th to 15th:** Another time for traditional travel to hometown areas, called the Obon season.

How to get the JR Sanyo Pass?

- The traveller must exchange the Exchange Order for a Japan West Rail Pass within 3 months from the date of issue.
- The starting date must be specified the date that you want to start using the pass. It can be any date within one month from the date the pass is received.
- Once the pass has a starting date written on it, the date cannot be changed.

Exchange Order+Passport=Japan Rail West (Sanyo Region) Pass

Where to turn the Exchange Order into a Japan Rail Sanyo Pass? Kansai Airport, Shin-Osaka, Osaka, Sannomiya, Okayama, Hiroshima, Shimonoseki, Shin-Shimonoseki, Kokura, Hakata.

II. Children's rule

- Free for children under 6 years old
- Pass prices for children apply from age 6 to and including age 11 (half fare).

III. Eligible Party

- Non Japanese passport holders are eligible to purchase or use a Japan West Rail Sanyo Pass.
- It is very important to note that Japanese passport holder cannot use any of the regional passes; they can only use the standard Japan Rail Pass if they meet the overseas residence requirements.

IV. Benefits

- Miyajima ferry line in Hiroshima that goes to Miyajima Island.

V. Conditions of use

- The pass is issued to and accepted by the person named on the ticket
- Travellers must board the Ordinary cars only
- A passport must be produced at the first time of purchase to verify the passenger is a resident of another country.
- The pass must be presented with the passport of the holder at the ticket office of the departure of the initial journey for validation and endorsing the Total period of availability on the Pass document.
- The passport with ticket is to be produced by the holder for all subsequent journeys at either the ticket office or to onboard staff for verification.
- The pass is only available for full adult and child fares.
- The traveller must exchange his Exchange Order for a Japan West Rail Sanyo Pass within three months from the date of issue. At that time, they must specify the date that they want to start using the PASS. It can be any date within one month from the date the PASS is received.
- Travellers cannot use an automatic ticket-reading gate with a Japan West Rail Sanyo Pass or a reserved-seat ticket. They have to show the PASS at a manned ticket gate.
- Once the PASS has a starting date written on it, the date cannot be changed. After commencing travel with the PASS beyond the valid period, it can be used until the day following its expiration date if no stops are made.
- If the trains boarded on that day have accommodations requiring limited express or express charges, the traveller must pay the applicable charges.
- During crowded periods travellers cannot be guaranteed a seat on a specific train.

VI. Refund

- No refund is payable on passes that have been validated, nor are refunds allowed on lost or stolen passes.
- Applications for refund on unused passes must be submitted to the issuing office within 12 months of the date of issue and a 10% refund fee is payable.
- For passes purchased overseas, refunds cannot be obtained in Japan.
- An Exchange Order that has not been submitted for a JAPAN WEST RAIL SANYO PASS can be returned to the office where it was purchased for a refund, within one year of the date of issue. In such cases, a handling fee and communication fee will be subtracted from the refund. No refund can be made for any reason on or after the starting date of the PASS.
- No refund on a SANYO PASS can be made in the event of train service delays or suspension, etc.
