



The Korea Rail Pass is the cheapest and most convenient way to explore South Korea. Check the validities and choose the right pass for your client.

I. Features

- The Korea Pass cannot be purchased in Korea.
- **You MUST book the Korail Pass the latest 5 days before your client travel to Korea.**
- The Korea Pass allows unlimited travel on all trains managed by KORAIL including the general seats of KTX as well as the Saemaeul and Mugunghwa trains (excluding the subways and tourist trains), without limit in terms of the travel section and the count.

KR PASS passengers could not be designated the general seats of KTX, Saemaeul and Mugunghwa trains during the Korea's big holidays, like the lunar New year's day, Thanksgiving day, summer vacation and year-end and the beginning of the year (standing Seats Possible).

- The Korea Train eXpress (KTX) is South Korea's high-speed rail system, which connects the capital Seoul to Busan and Mokpo. Operated by Korail, the system's technology is largely based on the French TGV/LGV system, and has a top speed of 350 km/h
- Gyeongbu Line: Seoul (Yongsan)->Gwangmyeong->Cheonan, Asan->Daejeon->East Daegu->milyang->Gupo->Busan
- Honam Line: Seoul (Yongsan)->Gwangmyeong->Cheonan, Asan->West Daejeon->Nonsan->Iksan->Gimje->Jeongeup->Jangseong->Songjeongli->Naju->Mokpo
- Reservation for KTX can be made locally at ticket counters in any station.

THE KORAIL PASS DOES NOT COVER

- Subways and tourist trains
- Please note that the Incheon airport-city centre route is not covered by the Korail Rail Pass as it is a subway line.

- Booking process on Euronet: for any Korail Rail Pass issued, you will get a PDF summarising the booking and which should be exchanged locally by the traveller.

II. Children's rule

- Child under the age of 4 is charge-free
- Child between 4 and 12 years old included is charged with 50% of adult fare

III. Eligible Party

- For non-Korean passport holders who enter Korea as a temporary visitor.
- Clients with Korean citizenship cannot use this pass except if the Korean (with PR passport) client has foreign citizenship or long-stay visa, then the client is able to use this pass.

V. Conditions of use

- The PDF voucher must be exchanged locally to obtain the Korea Rail Pass.
- The pass is issued to and accepted by the person named on the ticket
- This Pass is not transferable. One passenger only per Pass.
- A passport must be produced at the first time of purchase to verify the passenger is a resident of another country.
- The travel pass is a receipt only and does not guarantee travel.
- This pass must be presented with the passport of the holder at the ticket office of the departure of the initial journey for validation and endorsing the Total period of availability on the Pass document.
- The passport with ticket is to be produced by the holder for all subsequent journeys at either the ticket office or to onboard staff for verification.
- For full conditions and important travel tips please refer to the information provided with each operators travel ticket.
- The pass is only available for full adult, saver and child fares.
- The traveller must exchange the Exchange ticket for a Korea Rail Pass within 60 days from the date of issue.

VI. Refund

- No refund is payable on passes that have been validated, nor are refunds allowed on lost or stolen passes/exchange vouchers.
- Applications for refund on unused passes must be submitted to the issuing office within 12 months of the date of issue and a 10% refund fee is payable.
- For passes purchased overseas, refunds cannot be obtained in Korea.
- No refund on a Korea Rail Pass can be made in the event of train service delays or suspension, etc.
