

# Nice-Moscow



Travelling by train is the most stirring way to see real Russia. Moscow is easily connected to Western Europe, cities already connected to Moscow via regular train routes include Beijing, Berlin, Budapest, Helsinki, Prague and Ulan Bator, Mongolia.

The first Moscow-Nice express train has arrived on September 23rd 2010 at the French Riviera after an almost a century break. It covered a distance of more than 3,000 km within just 50 hours. From the end of the 19th century till the First World War, trains travelled regularly from Moscow to southern France, taking wealthy Russians and members of the Imperial House to the popular French resort. Nikolai Gogol, Fyodor Tyutchev and Anton Chekhov were enchanted by Nice. The city has hosted numerous Russian culture festivals and exhibitions as part of the Year of Russia in France and the Year of France in Russia.

- Train 17/18 connecting Nice to Moscow runs once a week all year long
- The journey from Nice to Moscow takes **53 hours**.

The train stops at 22 stations, cutting across Europe via Vyazma - Smolensk - Orsha - Minsk - Brest - Terespol - Warsaw - Katowice - Zebrydowice - Bohumin - BYeclav - Vienna - Linz - Innsbruck - Bolzano - Verona- Milan - Genoa - San Remo - Bordighera - Ventimiglia - Menton - Nice.

- Between Moscow and Brest, the train has two restaurant carriages of the Federal Passenger Company's Moscow subsidiary, and on the Warsaw - Nice - Warsaw part of the journey, the train has two restaurant carriages of the PKP Intercity company (Poland).

- The restaurant carriages offer Russian and European cuisine, with menus provided in Russian and English. Restaurant staff speak Russian, Polish, and English.

## Luggage

The ticket cost includes hand luggage of up to 35 kg for each adult ticket, and 15 kg per ticket for children under 12.

### III. Individual fares

Ticket prices for the whole Moscow - Nice journey range from 306 euros for second-class, up to 1200 euros for a deluxe-class compartment occupied by a single passenger. A flexible pricing system is in place for children up to 12, young people up to 26, and passengers over 60, as well as for groups of six or more passengers and travelling couples.
