Conditions valid from 01 Jan to 31 Dec 2010

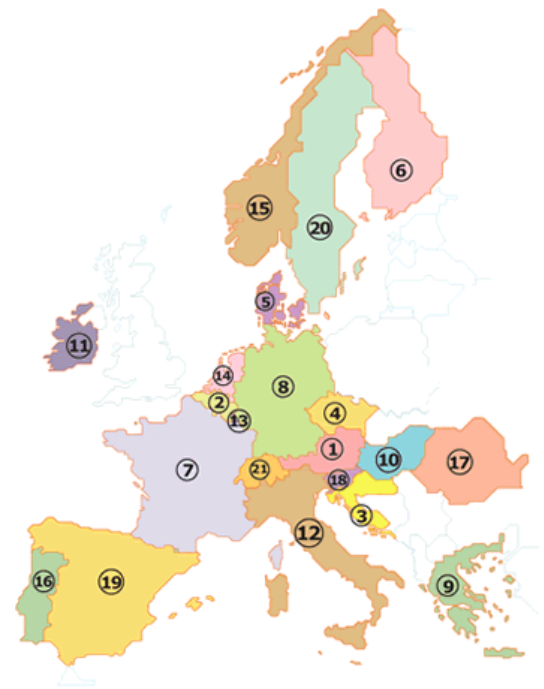

The Eurail Global pass is the best option for people staying a while within Europe and looking to discover many countries. Tailored formulas are available offering unlimited travel within 21 countries and travel bonuses.

I. Features

- **Passes are also valid on some major shipping lines**
- **1st class (adults/children) / 2nd class** (for youth travellers only, from 12 up to 25 years old included on the first day of travel)
- **2 Eurail Global passes :**
 - **Continuous formula for extensive travel**
Validities 15 days, 21 days, 1 month, 2 months and 3 months
 - **Flexi formula for full flexibility**
Validities 10 or 15 days in a 2-month period
Travel day may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- **Saver formula** for 2 to 5 persons travelling together at all times (a child is considered 1 person) in 1st class ONLY



▶ II. Children's rules

- Children up to 3 included on the first day of travel: free when sharing an adult passenger's seat/bed.
- Children from 4 up to 11 included on the first day of travel: half adult fare

▶ III. Eligible Party

- People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, the Russian Federation or Turkey are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Global Pass.

▶ IV. Access to High Speed Trains

- **Access to special trains:** IC (InterCity trains), EC (EuroCity trains), ICE (German high-speed train).
- **Reservation compulsory for:** TGV, Swiss Panoramic Trains, E* Italia, Cisalpino, X2000
- **Special Passholder fares on:**
Eurostar, Thalys, AVE, Talgo 200, Talgo Day, Spanish Day and Night Trains, Genève Med, France-Genève TGV, Lyria, Bruxelles-France TGV, X2000, Berlin-Warszawa Express, Artesia Day & Night, Paris-Germany Night, CityNightLine, Lusitania, Elipsos.

▶ V. Retail Fares (in EUR) & Benefits

- The different fares are available on the EXTRANET: Eurail 2010 prices.
- At the moment there are no extra pass benefits for Eurail pass holders in the following countries: Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Croatia, Luxembourg, Montenegro, Poland, Serbia, Slovenia

Benefits Rule: Travel bonuses may necessitate usage of a travel day.
For a full list of bonuses, please refer to the EURAIL map, traveller's guide or the spreadsheet available on your EXTRANET.

▶ VI. Conditions of use & Refunds

- **Conditions of use**
 - Passes must be validated within **6 months** of date of issue
 - Passes must be validated prior to first train journey / first use of bonus by a railway official in Europe (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
 - All parties must be present when validating a Eurail Global Pass Saver
 - **Flexipass:** The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train/ship, **by the traveller**, in the corresponding box of the calendar.
 - **7:00pm rule:**
 - If an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated **Eurail Regional Pass**, the Passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.
 - If an overnight train starts before 7:00pm on a validated **Eurail Regional Pass**, the Passholder has to fill in two days on the pass: the starting day's date AND the arrival day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.

- **Refunds**
 - Eurail Global Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
 - A 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned within **one year** of issuing date
 - The Eurail Global Passes are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used
