

Eurail Select Pass 2010

Conditions valid from 01 Jan to 31 Dec 2010

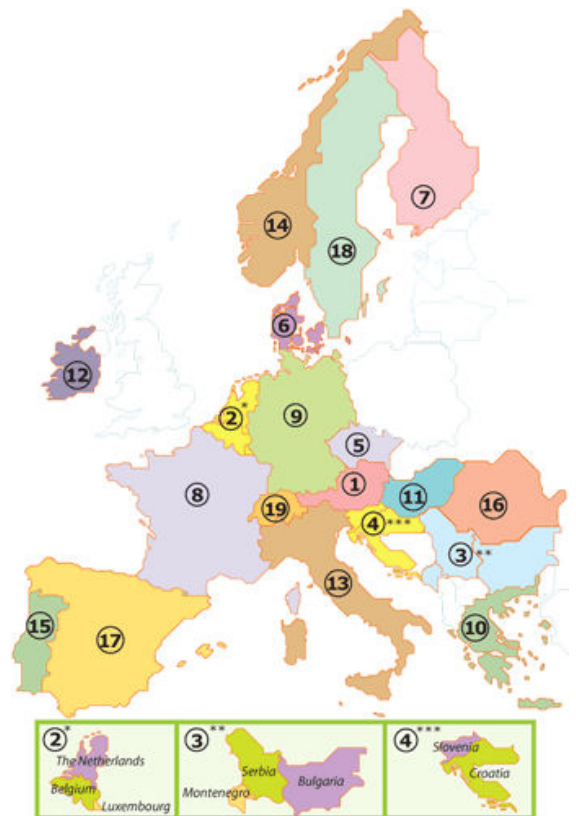
Boarding a train is the easiest way to travel within Europe. The traveller will benefit from a wide network of high speed and local trains. Moreover it offers a unique experience of travel, comfort, hassle-free journeys and wide range of destinations.

The Eurail Select Pass is the best option for people looking to visit a few European countries. Flexible formulas offer unlimited travel in 3 countries, up to 5 of the following 24 countries.

I. Features

- o Unlimited rail travel on the national rail networks of any 3, 4 or 5 adjoining Eurail countries that are connected by train or ship. To be chosen from the **24 participating countries:**

Liechtenstein and Monaco are considered part of Austria and France respectively

- o Some of the trains may transit through a country not covered by the pass. In that case **an** additional ticket must be purchased.
- o 1st class / 2nd class available for youth traveller only
- o Flexi formula: Validities 5, 6, 8, 10 days within a 2-month period + 15 days within 2 months for 5 countries
- o Travel day may be used consecutively or non-consecutively
- o Saver formula for 2 to 5 persons travelling together at all times (a child is considered 1 person)
- o Youth formula in 2nd class only, for traveller from 12 up to 25 included on the first day of travel



II. Adjoining countries rules

The chosen countries must be bordering, and be linked by a direct (not through another country) train or shipping line which is part of the existing Eurail offer (see details in the Internet Eurail Sales Manual).

E.G.: France, Benelux and Germany are three adjoining countries

Note: Norway and Finland **not** considered as adjoining countries. They have a joint border, but to get by train from Norway to Finland you have to pass through Sweden.

Ireland is adjoining France or Benelux
Italy is adjoining Spain

Belgium/Netherlands/Luxembourg are considered as one country, called Benelux
Bulgaria / Serbia & Montenegro are considered as one country.
Croatia / Slovenia are considered as one country.

III. Children's rule

- Children up to 3 included on the first day of travel: free when sharing an adult passenger's seat / bed
- Children from 4 up to 11 included on the first day of travel: half adult fare



▶ **IV. Eligible Party**

- People with a permanent residence (for more than 6 months) outside of Europe, the United Kingdom, the Russian Federation or Turkey are eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Select Pass.

▶ **V. Access to High Speed Trains**

- **Access to special trains:** IC (InterCity trains), EC (EuroCity trains), ICE (German high-speed train).
- **Reservation compulsory for:** TGV, Swiss Panoramic Trains, E* Italia, Cisalpino, X2000
- **Special Passholder fares on:**
Eurostar, Thalys, AVE, Talgo 200, Talgo Day, Spanish Day and Night Trains, Genève Med, France-Genève TGV, Lyria, Bruxelles-France TGV, X2000, Berlin-Warszawa Express, Artesia Day & Night, Paris-Germany Night, CityNightLine, Lusitania, Elipsos.

▶ **VI. Conditions of use & Refunds**

- **Conditions of use**
 - Passes must be validated in 6 months of issue date
 - Passes must be validated by a railway official in one of the countries mentioned on the Eurail Select Pass (station's desk) who also fills in the passport number
 - All parties must be present when validating a Eurail Select Pass Saver
 - The date of travel has to be entered in the correct way before boarding the first train, by the traveler, in the corresponding box of the calendar
 - 7:00pm rule:
 - If an overnight train starts after 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Select Pass, the Passholder must enter the next day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.
 - If an overnight train starts before 7:00pm on a validated Eurail Select Pass, the Passholder has to fill in two days on the pass: the starting day's date AND the arrival day's date on the pass, provided it falls within the validity of the pass.

** Comprehensive conditions of use on the Eurail cover*

- **Refunds**
 - Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated
 - An 85% refund applies to totally unused passes returned in **one year** of issuing date
 - Eurail Select Passes are not refundable and cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or partially used

▶ **VII. Retail Fares (in EUR) & Benefits**

- The different fares are available on the EXTRANET: Eurail 2010 prices.
- At the moment there are no extra pass benefits for Eurail pass holders in the following countries: Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Croatia, Luxembourg, Montenegro, Poland, Serbia, Slovenia
- **Benefits Rule:** Travel bonuses may necessitate usage of a travel day.
