

Amsterdam Schiphol Airport:

- There is a train from Schiphol Airport to Amsterdam Central Station every 15 minutes. Journey time is about 20 minutes.
- There are also frequent direct trains from the airport to many other destinations in the Netherlands and even to Belgium, France and Germany.

BERLIN

Berlin-Schoenefeld Airport:

- Berlin-Schoenefeld Airport is located 18 km of the city centre.
- The Airport Express (Regional Express RE4 and RE5) runs every 30 minutes to Berlin Ostbahnhof (15 minutes) and Berlin Zoologischer Garten (30 minutes).
- The S-Bahn S9 also runs from Schoenefeld Airport to the centre.
- ICE/IC/EC trains run directly from the airport to Berlin, Hamburg, Dresden, Leipzig, Nuremberg, Munich and IR trains to Berlin and Chemnitz.

Berlin-Tegel Airport:

- There is a bus to Berlin Zoo station (Bus 109 or X9) every 10 minutes.

Berlin-Tempelhof Airport:

- Berlin-Tempelhof Airport is located on the U6 underground line, at the Platz der Luftbruecke. There are also connections with Bus 119.

Information for all airports in Berlin:

Valid Passes: Rail Passes are valid on the S-Bahn and on DB trains (including the Airport Express), but not on the U-Bahn and the buses.

Birmingham International Airport:

- Birmingham International Airport is at the heart of UK's rail network and served by over 200 trains per day (Intercity, regional and local rail services).
- Trains stop at Birmingham International Interchange, only 500 metres from the Airport Passenger Terminals. The station is linked by the automatic *SkyRail* system.

Valid Passes: BritRail Pass is valid to/from Birmingham International Interchange.

SkyRail is free.

Brussels Airport:

- There is a train station within the airport, located in the basement (level -1).
- Four times an hour the Airport City Express runs from Brussels Airport to any of the Brussels railway stations Nord/Noord, Central/Centraal or Midi/Zuid. Journey time from the airport to Brussels Central station is 20 minutes.
- In addition to the shuttle service to and from Brussels, there are direct links with the west and south of Belgium.
- The name of the railway station at the airport is "Zaventem Airport".

Budapest Airport:

- Budapest Airport (Ferihegy) is located 24 km outside the centre.
- An airport bus service (marked #93) runs every 30 minutes to the centre (except on Sundays). Journey time is around 30 minutes.
- There is also an Airport Shuttle ("Reptér Busz") which runs every 10-20 minutes. Journey time is 22 minutes.
- There are also Minibuses, that take you to any place in town you want to go.

Copenhagen Airport (Kastrup):

- There is a railway station at the Airport, only 60 metres from the arrival hall.
- Trains to Copenhagen Central run 3 to 5 times every hour with connections to the rest of Denmark. The journey to Copenhagen Central takes 12 minutes.
- There are also a few direct connections from Copenhagen Airport to other cities in Denmark or Sweden.
- The direct high speed train X2000 from Copenhagen to Stockholm stops at Copenhagen Airport. The travel time is about 5 hours.

- Dublin airport is located in the north of Dublin City. There are many bus services going to the city centre or to nearby train stations (Heuston, Connolly or Howth Junction Dart).

Frankfurt Airport:

- Frankfurt Airport has two railway stations. One for long distance trains (Frankfurt Flughafen Fernbahnhof) and one for local trains (Frankfurt Flughafen Regiobahnhof).
- The Frankfurt Flughafen Fernbahnhof (long distance trains) has connections with ICE and IC/EC trains to many cities in Germany and the neighbouring countries.
- The Frankfurt Flughafen Regiobahnhof (local trains) has connections with the S-Bahn (S8 + S9) to Frankfurt main station and various destinations in the Frankfurt area. Frequency is every 10-15 minutes and travel time is about 15 minutes.

Valid Passes: All Rail Passes covering Germany are valid, also on the S-Bahn.

- An Aerobus (Bus no. 91) runs between Lisbon Airport and the centre of town. Tickets can be purchased on board. (They are valid for a day and for any other ride with the bus, tram and downtown elevators.)
- Several other buses run between the Airport and a number of places in town.

LONDON

London Gatwick Airport:

- London Gatwick Airport is located 45 km south of London and has its own railway station. Three options are to be found to go to the centre.
- *Gatwick Express* – a dedicated rail link between Gatwick Airport and London Victoria Station. Trains depart every 15 minutes. Journey time is 30 minutes.
- *Connex* – one of Britain's private Train Operating Companies, runs a commuter service between Gatwick and London Victoria. As this service makes stops en route, the service takes a little longer.
- *Thameslink* – offers a commuter service between Gatwick and London Kings Cross Thameslink Station, which is about 200 metres from Kings Cross mainline terminal. Service operates approximately every 30 minutes. This service is best if you are going directly to Kings Cross for trains to Scotland. This route helps to avoid a tube/taxi transfer.

London Heathrow Airport:

- One of the world's busiest airports, London Heathrow is located about 25 km west from London. There is a multitude of different ways to get from Heathrow to London.
- *Heathrow Express* – From Heathrow Airport to London Paddington in just 15 minutes. Trains depart Heathrow every 15 minutes.
- *London Underground* – Heathrow Airport is on the underground's Piccadilly Line, which services London Euston and Kings Cross Stations. The journey time from Heathrow to Central London/Kings Cross or Euston is about 1 hour.

Valid Passes: BritRail Passes are valid on the Heathrow Express, but not on the underground.

Madrid Barajas Airport:

- Madrid-Barajas is located 13 km to the northeast of Madrid.
- The Spanish Railway Network (Red de Ferrocarriles Españoles - RENFE) does not go to Madrid-Barajas airport.
- The underground (Line 8) leaves from the airport, and there are also several buses going to the city centre.

Milan Airport Malpensa:

- There is no direct train from Milano Centrale to the airport. You need to take the underground to Cadorna station. From there take the Malpensa Express, that leaves every 30 minutes. Journey time is 40 minutes.
- There are also different buses, that connect the airport with the city.

- Munich Airport is 28,5 km northeast of the centre of Munich.
- The S-Bahn (S1 + S8) go to Munich main station and other downtown destinations.
- Frequency is every 10 minutes and journey time is about 45 minutes.
- The S-Bahn arrives at the station Muenchen Tief, which is situated in the basement of the main station.

Valid Passes: All Rail Passes covering Germany are valid, also on the S-Bahn.

Airport Nice Côte d'Azur:

- The train station Nice Ville is located 10 km from the airport.
- There is a bus (Line 99 SNCF Direct) which goes directly to the train station. It takes 20 minutes and leaves every half an hour.
- The busline 23 also goes to the train station, but the journey takes 45 minutes. Frequency: every 15 minutes.
- From Nice Ville train station national and international connections are to be found.
- Nice St Augustin and St Laurent du Var are regional train stations closer to the airport. Only regional trains leave from there.

Oslo Airport (Gardermoen):

- *Airport Express:* There is an Airport Express which goes from the Airport to downtown Oslo. The journey lasts 20 minutes and trains run every 10 minutes. (with few exceptions).
- *Norwegian State Railways (NSB):* All InterCity and Express Trains on the stretch Skien - Oslo - Lillehammer - Trondheim run via Oslo Airport. Travel Time approx. 25 minutes.

Valid Passes: Scanrail Pass, Eurail Pass and Eurail Select Pass are not valid on the Airport Express, but on the regular trains of the Norwegian State Railways.

PARIS

Paris (Charles de Gaulle Airport):

- Charles de Gaulle Airport (Roissy) is located 23 km north of Paris.
- The Airport has an own TGV train station. This offers a wide range of connections to passengers arriving by plane. Some TGV lines pass through this station, and also Thalys.
- For passengers going to Paris, you can take the local train (RER B), which takes about 40 minutes. There are also buses that go to the centre. (Either Roissy Bus to Opera or the Air France airport Bus to Arc de Triomphe.) Buses leave every 15 minutes.

Paris (Orly Airport):

- Orly Airport is located 14 km from the centre.
- Passengers going to Paris can either take the Orlybus which arrives at the RER and metro station Denfert-Rochereau in the South of Paris, or the connection Orlyval to the RER-station Antony and then further to the centre.
- There is also an Air France bus which goes to Invalides. The bus leaves every 12 minutes.

*) The Rail Passes are valid on the RER B only. When connecting to another place around Paris, Passes are no longer valid. By using a Rail Pass on this route, Passengers have to use one full day of validity which is not necessarily worth it.

To use the Rail Pass on the RER B, passengers need to go to the ticket counter to get a small ticket to pass the barrier.

For tourists visiting Paris for a couple of days, there are special tickets like “Paris Visit”, which can be bought locally.

Pisa (Galileo Galilei) International Airport:

- Galileo Galilei is the international airport serving Pisa and Florence. It is located 1 km away from Pisa, and 80 km from Florence.
- The airport has an own railway terminal which is connected to Pisa Central Station and from there to the Italian railway network.
- Pisa Airport and Florence railway station are connected by 10 direct trains a day. Journey time is just over 1 hour.

Valid Passes: All Rail Passes covering Italy are valid.

- There is an airport shuttle (Arlanda Express) between Stockholm Central Station and Arlanda Airport. The travel time is 19 minutes and there are four trains every hour during the whole day.
- Many long distance and regional SJ trains stop at Arlanda Airport making it possible to travel directly from Arlanda to your final destination in the Mälardalen region as well as in the north of Sweden.
