▶ SWITZERLAND BAGGAGE

With "Fly Rail Baggage" you are able to check in your baggage from South Africa directly to your railway station in Switzerland via Zurich or Geneva Airport. This means you arrive at the airport and your baggage is automatically forwarded to your destination station. Thus you don't have to waste time waiting to collect baggage.

On your return flight you can also check-in your baggage at the train station which will then be transported by rail to the aircraft. You will receive your boarding card at the same time with your specific seat on the plane.

For baggage services within Switzerland you have the option of "Fast Baggage". You hand in your baggage before 09h00 in the morning, to ensure it arrives by 18h00 at the latest on the same day at your destination point. This is extremely convenient if you do not wish to travel with your baggage.
